Enclosed, please find a complete information regarding Borrego Springs Tennis Center in this newsletter.

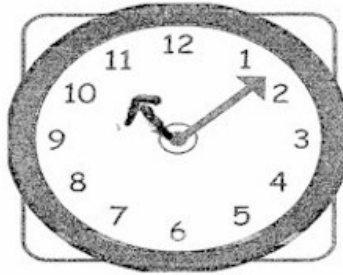

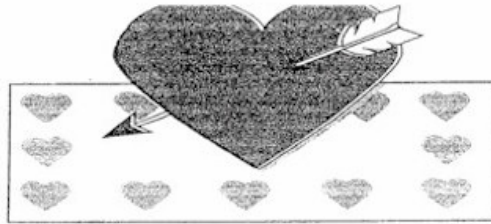

HOW'S YOUR TENNIS ETIQUETTE?!

There have been some complaints of poor tennis etiquette on our courts. Here's a quick 'do' and 'do not' list using incidents that have happened on our Magnolia Courts recently:

A FEW DOs and DON'Ts:

NEVER WALK ONTO A COURT DURING A GAME

Wait outside until the players tell you to come in, or their game finishes.

NEVER RETRIEVE YOUR BALL FROM THE NEXT COURT.

If your ball goes onto the next court, immediately call "BALL ON". This will avoid accidents and stop play. Once your ball is tossed back to you, play a 'let'.

NEVER CROSS A MIDDLE COURT IF A GAME IS GOING ON

Even if you wait for the players to finish the point and then run across, this is very distracting.

DO NOT COACH, CRITICIZE OR USE LOUD VOICES.

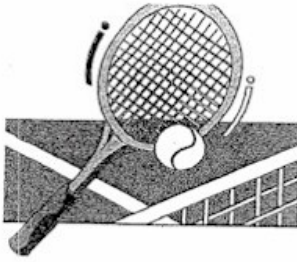
DO BRING NEW BALLS TO EVERY MATCH.

DO TURN OFF YOUR CELL PHONE DURING PLAY.

If a vital call is expected, warn your players. They will be more tolerant.

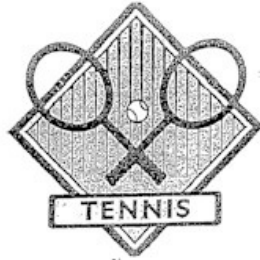

TUSTIN TENNIS CLUB BOARD AND CHAIR POSITIONS

BOARD (*Brief descriptions of responsibilities*)

PRESIDENT: Runs monthly meetings. Prepares agenda. Deals with problems and suggestions.

VICE PRESIDENT: Helps the President. Takes over meetings if the president cannot attend.

SECRETARY: Takes minutes of monthly board meetings. Submits minutes to the newsletter.

TREASURER: Prepares statements, budgets, state and federal tax returns. Takes care of deposits, withdrawals and balances. Gives board updates on spending and budget.

TOURNAMENT/TEAM TENNIS DIRECTOR: In charge of tournaments and team tennis.

All members may attend meetings and give suggestions, complaints and ideas. Only the board may vote on the matter.

CHAIRPERSONS (*Brief descriptions of positions.*)

WEBSITE: Manage and update our website. May also add and design as you wish..

Messages and updates will be e-mailed to you from the chairpersons and board members

GETAWAYS: Organizes dates, contracts and collection of deposit checks for two weekend getaways. May also arrange club exchange(s) with other clubs

MEMBERSHIP: Receives membership forms, deposits checks. Updates the membership list. Answers inquiries about the club. Contacts new members about our activities.

NEWSLETTER: Publishes the Newsletter. Organizes reports from board members, chairpersons and other members for publishing. (Assistant helps with labels and mailing.).

PHOTOGRAPHER: Takes photos at club events. Posts them on the bulletin board when available and gives copies to the historian.

PUBLICITY: Submits articles and photos to the Tustin News and Irvine World News about club events.

ACTIVITIES: Arranges trips to local cultural & sports events. Max. 10 per group. New position.

SOCIAL: Heads up a committee to help arrange two events during the year: the picnic in May and the Christmas/Holiday party

SUNDOWNERS CAPTAIN: (Our club women's team for inter-club competitive league).
Captain organizes team and roster. Attends meetings, checks on ratings and club membership.

SUNSHINE: Sends greeting cards to members for various reasons such as illness, congratulations etc. Also sends flowers where appropriate.

HISTORIAN: Takes care of the photo albums of the club's history. Brings them to the membership picnic in May. Adds to the albums with current photos from the club photographer

BULLETIN BOARD: Upkeeps the bulletin board with current events provided from the committee chairperson or Newsletter. Gets club brochures printed and refills the Bulletin box..
