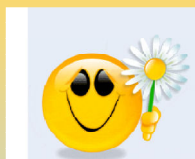

As an example Poaching is a move where the person closest to the net is in a position to strike the ball before his/her partner near the base line strikes the ball. The poaching player is positioned about 2 to 4 feet from the net, and just before the opponent strikes the ball, moves either two steps to the left or two steps to the right in anticipation of where the ball will cross the net. The timing of this move is critical. If it is too soon it will alert the opponent, and if the move is too late, then the poacher may not have the racquet in place to make the shot.
