

Family Membership

DEFINITION:

A "Family Membership" is defined as consisting of the regular member, their spouse and dependents living in the same household above the age of twelve. Family members under the age of 18 are further defined as a junior member(s) for the purpose of this document.

COST:

The cost of a family membership is the sum total of the cost of the regular member plus the cost of each individual member above the age of twelve, who join the club.

RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES:

Each family member above the age of 18 has full rights and privileges to all events and activities offered by the club. Junior members have restricted rights as follows:

1. Cannot cast a vote in any election including, but not limited to, members of the board and special elections.
2. Must play with the same full member when participating in any tennis activity. In essence, the full member is sponsoring the junior member and agrees to play with the junior member whenever the junior member is playing on the court.
3. Can only participate in junior tournaments.
4. Can only participate in the junior ladder.
5. Can only participate in social gatherings designated to include junior members. These include, but not limited to, get-a-ways and parties.
