## **RECIPES**

Irene has a couple of recipes for us to try during these hot summer months.

#### MEDITERRANEAN QUINOA SALAD

- 1 cup quinoa, cooked in 3 cups of water, with 2 chicken bouillon cubes
- 1 lemon, juiced
- 1/2 c parsley, chopped
- 1 shallot, chopped
- 2 cloves of garlic, minced
- 1 cucumber, halved and sliced
- 1 can (16 oz.) olives, sliced
- 1 T fresh thyme, chopped, or 1 tsp dried thyme
- 1 basket of cherry tomatoes, halved
- 10 oz. crumbled feta cheese
- 1 t pepper
- 2 t cumin
- 1 avocado, chopped
- salt, if needed

#### BRUSCHETTA QUINOA SALAD

- 1 cup quinoa, cooked in 3 cups of water, with 2 chicken bouillon cubes
- 1 cucumber, halved and sliced
- 1 basket cherry tomatoes, halved
- 6 oz. olives, sliced
- 1 c mozzarella, shredded

1 c parmesan, shredded

1/2 chopped fresh basil, or 1 tsp. dried basil

1/2 c parsley, chopped

1/2 c chives, chopped

2 lemons, juiced

4 T olive oil

2 T balsamic vinegar

2 cloves of garlic, minced

1 t pepper

1 c pine nuts, or chopped walnuts

salt, if needed
